# INTRODUCTION

## 簡介

With its commitment to Whole Person Education, Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU) has nurtured over 178,000 graduates since its establishment in 1956. Many of the University's alumni have made outstanding achievements and have used their expertise to make contributions to Hong Kong and the global community, enhancing HKBU's reputation. HKBU presents the Distinguished Alumni Award to recognise the distinguished business, professional or scholastic achievements of its alumni, and their service and contributions to the University and society. The award also aims to motivate students to learn from the experience and success of the award recipients.

The nominees for the award must be alumni of HKBU (or its forerunner Hong Kong Baptist College). Each nominee must be proposed by a nominator and seconded by two supporters who are alumni, current or former full-time staff members, current or former Council Members, Court Members or Honorary Court Members of HKBU. The Selection Committee will consider the suitability of each nomination based on a set of criteria including the nominee's business, professional or scholastic achievements, as well as service and contributions to HKBU and society.

# INTRODUCTION OF AWARD RECIPIENTS

## 得獎人介紹



### The Hon Chan Hoi-yan

Communication / Media Management

The Hon Chan Hoi-yan is currently a member of the Legislative Council (Election Committee) of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) of the People's Republic of China. She is one of the seasoned professionals successfully bridging the worlds of media management and public administration. Ms Chan's academic foundation is solidly grounded in HKBU, where she obtained a Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) in Communication in 1999, followed by a Master of Social Sciences in Media Management in 2008. Her diverse career experience — spanning broadcast journalism, public administration, social entrepreneurship, and public governance — stands as a testament to her lifelong commitment to social good.

Ms Chan's professional journey began in the demanding and versatile environment of television news. She joined Television Broadcasts Limited (TVB News) in 1998 and was gradually promoted to Senior Reporter and Anchor, honing her skills in public communication and investigative journalism. In 2005, she joined Now TV where she assisted in setting up the Now Business News Channel and the News Channel. Prior to joining the government in 2012, she served as News Editor for Now TV's News and Business Information channel, overseeing daily news editing and reporting, with a special focus on medical news. She also served as the Executive Producer and host of the medical programme *Medicine Online*, which has become a long-standing success, garnering positive recognition. These experiences allowed her to develop a profound understanding of social and public health issues, which would later become the cornerstone of the success of her political career.

In 2012, Ms Chan was appointed the Political Assistant for Dr Ko Wing-man, the then Secretary for Food and Health of the Government of the HKSAR. During her five-year tenure, she acted as a vital bridge between the government and the public, navigating between legislative lobbying and policy formulation. Following her term as a political appointee, she demonstrated her commitment to social responsibility by becoming the CEO of a social enterprise, promoting social inclusion for the elderly and the visually impaired. Driven by her passion for serving the community, she actively participated in community affairs. She also established a public relations consultancy, leveraging her experiences accumulated in media and public administration. Currently a member of the Legislative Council (Election Committee) of the HKSAR, she channels her insights into various social issues for the public good, staying committed to her original aspiration. In the legislature, she is recognised as a pragmatic voice, championing issues such as healthcare reform, housing policy, and the rights of the grassroots communities.

Beyond her legislative duties, Ms Chan has demonstrated a strong sense of social responsibility by taking up a number of community leadership positions. Her extensive list of public appointments includes, for instance, a member of the Standing Committee of the Foshan Municipal Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference, a member of the Consumer Council, a member of the Intangible Cultural Heritage Advisory Committee, and a Non-Executive Director of the eMPF Platform Company Limited.

Ms Chan's loyalty to HKBU remains unwavering. She is a frequent and familiar face at HKBU events, often volunteering her professional talents as an emcee for major occasions such as the University's 50th Anniversary Variety Show, the 60th Anniversary Alumni Show and numerous Homecoming events. She also spares no effort in sharing her insights and experiences at sharing forums. In recognition of her exceptional career trajectory and her significant contributions to the field of communication, she was honoured with the Distinguished Alumni Communicator Award by the HKBU School of Communication in 2008. Ms Chan consistently serves as an inspiration to students and alumni, embodying the values of service, professionalism, and community care.

## 陳凱欣議員 傳理學 / 傳媒管理

陳凱欣議員是現任中華人民共和國香港特別行政區（香港特區）立法會議員（選舉委員會），她是其中一位成功橫跨傳媒管理與公共行政領域的資深專業人士。陳女士堅實的學術基礎始於香港浸會大學，她先於1999年取得傳理學社會科學學士（榮譽）學位，隨後於2008年獲得傳媒管理社會科學碩士學位。在其職業生涯中，她馳騁於廣播新聞、公共行政、社會企業及公共管治多個範疇，充分體現了她以服務社會、造福民生為其終生事業的決心。

陳女士於瞬息萬變的電視新聞界展開其專業新聞之路。1998年，她加入無綫電視新聞部，其後逐步晉升為高級記者及主播，奠下了紮實的公共傳播與調查報道的根基。2005年，她轉職至Now寬頻電視，協助籌備Now財經台與新聞台開台。直至2012年加入政府前，她擔任Now寬頻電視新聞及財經資訊部採訪主任，負責日常新聞編採工作，尤其專注於醫療新聞，同時兼任醫療節目《杏林在線》的監製及主持，節目深受好評，並一直播放至今。這些經歷促使她對社會民生與公共衛生議題有深切的認識，成為其日後於政治生涯取得成功的重要基石。

2012年，陳女士獲委任為香港特區政府食物及衛生局局長政治助理，協助時任局長高永文醫生。在五年的任期內，她擔任政府與市民之間的溝通橋樑，參與立法會游說工作及政策的制訂，在公共行政領域累積了豐厚經驗。度過五年的問責官員生涯後，她轉任為慈善機構的行政總裁，繼續履行社會責任，投身慈善工作，推動長者及視障人士的社會共融。本著服務社區的熱誠，陳女士其後開展參與地區事務及發展工作，同時成立公關顧問公司，運用多年累積的傳媒及從政經驗拓展個人業務。目前，她擔任香港特區立法會議員（選舉委員會），秉持初心，其對於社會議題的洞見轉化為推動公眾利益的行動。在議會中，她以務實見稱，積極推動基層醫療改革、房屋政策及保障弱勢社群權益等議題，致力為市民大眾謀求福祉。

除了議會工作外，陳女士亦積極履行社會責任，出任多項公職。她目前擔任中國人民政治協商會議佛山市委員會常務委員、消費者委員會委員、非物質文化遺產諮詢委員會委員，以及積金易平台有限公司非執行董事等，透過不同公職以回饋社會。

陳女士對母校浸大的情誼始終如一。她活躍於浸大的活動，經常義務參與及擔任重大慶典的司儀，例如大學五十周年校慶綜藝匯演、六十周年校慶校友 Show 以及不同年度的校友日活動。她亦熱衷於走進校園，與學弟學妹分享其見解及心路歷程。為表揚她在傳媒領域的傑出表現與貢獻，浸大傳理學院於2008年向她頒發「傑出傳理人獎」。陳女士憑藉其服務大眾的熱忱、專業敬業的精神與關懷社會的宗旨，誠為學生與校友的楷模。

## 得獎人介紹



**Dr Wilson Cheung Wai-yin, PhD**  
Physical Education and Recreation Management

Dr Wilson Cheung Wai-yin graduated from HKBU in 2010 with a Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education and Recreation Management. Driven by a passion for polar research and expeditions, he pursued further studies and subsequently earned a Doctor of Philosophy in Glaciology from Queen's University in Canada. Today, he is a world-recognised glaciologist, polar expedition specialist, and social entrepreneur, blending impactful polar research with superb expedition leadership. Having founded the Polar Research & Expedition Consultancy (PRECon) in 2015, Dr Cheung has relentlessly dedicated his life to *ground-truthing* — the essential work of travelling to remote polar environments to verify satellite data with on-the-ground observations. His work provides the global scientific community with critical insights into glacier retreat, snowline monitoring, and climate change, all of which are vital for future water resource management and hence contribute tremendously to the public good.

For over a decade, Dr Cheung's professional excellence has been defined by landmark scientific achievements in the polar regions. He pioneered the establishment of the first glacier mass-balance monitoring networks in Auyuittuq and Sirmilik National Parks in Canada. By utilising historical aerial photogrammetry and modern measurement techniques of geodetic mass balance, he successfully constructed a detailed analysis of glacier change spanning 1958–2024. This provided important baseline evidence now used for global sea-level assessments and water-resource planning for Inuit communities. His expertise is further demonstrated by his development of satellite data-fusion methods that combine Sentinel-2 optical imagery with machine learning to estimate snowline altitudes across the Arctic.

Dr Cheung has received numerous international honours for his significant contributions to science and society. He was named among the Ten Outstanding Young Persons of the World by Junior Chamber International (JCI) in 2025 and the Ten Outstanding Young Persons by JCI Hong Kong, China in 2023. In 2022, The Explorers Club listed him in The Explorers Club 50, which recognises and honours the world's leading explorers. His additional recognition includes Fellow of the Royal Canadian Geographical Society (2025), Fellow of the International Arctic Science Committee (2022) and Fellow of the Royal Geographical Society (2019). He also co-chaired in 2025 the Fourth International Conference on Arctic Research Planning (ICARP IV) research priority team under the International Arctic Science Committee (IASC), where he helps shape the Arctic research agendas.

Beyond his polar research, Dr Cheung is committed to youth empowerment. He founded the Asia Youth Alpine Mentorship Program (AYAMP), offering a useful platform for veteran polar explorers to share their expertise and mentor aspiring young explorers. Through this programme, he equips young people with essential technical skills and fosters environmental awareness for protecting the cryosphere. This also shows his devotion to making scientific knowledge accessible to the public.

A dedicated HKBU alumnus, Dr Cheung truly exemplifies the University's philosophy of whole-person education. He regularly gives back to the HKBU community by sharing his experiences, including serving as a guest speaker for General Education courses inspiring students on climate change and sustainability, presenting at alumni sharing forums, and delivering a keynote speech to students on resilience and faith. Through his scientific endeavours, personal resilience, and unwavering support for his *alma mater*, Dr Cheung serves as a role model, demonstrating how an HKBU education can create a lasting global influence.

## 張偉賢博士, PhD 體育及康樂管理學

張偉賢博士於 2010 年畢業於香港浸會大學，取得體育及康樂管理學士學位。憑藉對極地研究與遠征的滿腔熱忱，他朝著這方面深造，並於加拿大皇后大學取得冰川學博士學位。張博士現已成為享譽國際的冰川學家、極地遠征專家及社會企業家，將他在極地遠征方面的卓越領導能力完美融入於影響深遠的極地科學研究。他於 2015 年創立 PRECon 極地科研及遠征顧問公司，多年來積極進行「地面實測」的工作，親自前往偏遠極地，以實地觀測驗證衛星數據。他的研究為全球科學界提供了有關冰川消融、雪線監測及氣候變化的關鍵數據，對未來水資源管理帶來重要的啟示，為社會公共利益作出了重大貢獻。

過去十多年間，張博士在極地科研領域締造了多項里程碑，成就超卓。他率先在加拿大奧尤特克及謝米里克國家公園建立了首個冰川物質平衡監測網絡。透過結合歷史性航空攝影測量與現代大地測量技術，他成功製作了橫跨 1958 至 2024 年的冰川變化詳細分析報告，為全球海平面評估及因紐特社區水資源規劃提供了至關重要的基準證據。此外，他開發了融合 Sentinel-2 光學影像與機器學習的衛星數據融合方法，用以估算北極地區的雪線高度。

張博士對科學及社會的傑出貢獻深受國際肯定，屢獲殊榮。他於 2025 年獲國際青年商會 (JCI) 選為「世界十大傑出青年」，並於 2023 年獲 JCI 中國香港總會選為「十大傑出青年」。2022 年，他獲美國探索者協會評為「世界 50 名最具影響力探險家」之一，彰顯他在極地研究及探險方面的貢獻及成就。此外，他亦先後獲頒加拿大皇家地理學會會士 (2025)、國際北極科學委員會會士 (2022) 及英國皇家地理學會會士 (2019) 等名銜。2025 年，他更帶領國際北極科學委員會 (IASC) 旗下的第四屆國際北極研究規劃會議 (ICARP IV) 重點研究小組，協助制定國際極地研究議程。

除了極地研究，張博士亦熱衷於推動青年賦權。他創辦了「亞洲青年探險導師計劃」(AYAMP)，為經驗豐富的極地探險家與有志青年建立溝通橋樑，讓資深專家向年青一代傳授技能並培養保護冰雪圈的環保意識，致力將科學知識普及化。

作為浸大校友，張博士身體力行、實踐浸大全人教育的理念。他經常回饋母校，不僅為通識課程擔任客席講者，啟發學生對於氣候變化與可持續發展議題的關注及認識，亦曾主講校友分享會，以及與學生分享以心理韌性與信念為題的專題演講。張博士憑藉科學探索的追求、堅定無比的毅力以及對母校的熱心支持，是浸大校友的模範，充分展示浸大的教育如何締造長久深遠的全球影響力。



# INTRODUCTION OF AWARD RECIPIENTS

## 得獎人介紹



**Professor William Cho Chi-shing, PhD**  
Chinese Medicine

Professor William Cho Chi-shing earned his Doctor of Philosophy in Chinese Medicine from HKBU in 2006. Currently serving as Scientific Officer (Medical) in the Department of Clinical Oncology at Queen Elizabeth Hospital, he is a distinguished biomedical scientist with an outstanding career marked by significant achievements and transformative impact on global clinical cancer research. For decades, he has tirelessly advanced medical science, making substantial contributions to both research discovery and clinical application to improve therapeutic outcomes.

Professor Cho's professional standing is reflected in the numerous fellowship honours he has received from professional organisations worldwide. He has been a Fellow of the Institute of Biomedical Science (FIBMS) in the United Kingdom since 1998, a Fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of Medical Laboratory Sciences (FHKIMLS) and a Fellow of the Hong Kong Society for Molecular Diagnostic Sciences (FHKSMDS) since 2003. Furthermore, he has been recognised as a Chartered Scientist by the Science Council (UK) since 2004, a testament to his exemplary professional competence and contributions in the scientific arena.

Throughout his career, Professor Cho has focused on some of the most challenging questions in oncology: Can we detect cancer and identify relapse earlier through biomarkers? How do cancers become resistant to treatment, and how can such resistance be overcome? His multidisciplinary work spans molecular biology, genomics, immunology, bioinformatics, and Chinese medicine, with particular emphasis on cancer biomarkers, proteomics, non-coding RNA, extracellular vesicles, and novel anti-cancer therapeutics. His contributions to biomarker studies in lung cancer, nasopharyngeal carcinoma, and colorectal cancer have informed personalised treatment strategies.

As a prominent clinical scientist, Professor Cho has published over 700 peer-reviewed articles in internationally recognised scientific journals, including *Annals of Oncology*, *The Lancet Oncology*, *Molecular Cancer*, and the *Journal of Thoracic Oncology*. His work has achieved global influence, with over 35,000 citations and an H-index of 108. Since 2017, Professor Cho has been named on Stanford University's list of the world's top 2% scientists. Additionally, in both 2023 and 2024, he was recognised as a "Highly Cited Researchers" by Clarivate Analytics, an honour awarded to fewer than 7,000 scholars worldwide. He remains one of the very few scholars within the Hospital Authority to attain this prestigious global recognition.

Beyond journal publications, Professor Cho is a prolific author, with over 36 academic books held by the libraries of renowned universities worldwide. His notable works include *Resistance to Anti-CD20 Antibodies and Approaches for Their Reversal* (Academic Press) as well as multiple volumes published by Springer Nature, such as *An Omics Perspective on Cancer Research* and book series *Evidence-based Anticancer Complementary and Alternative Medicine*. Through this book series, he has been a key driver in advancing evidence-based traditional Chinese medicine on the world stage.

Professor Cho is deeply grateful to his *alma mater* for laying a solid foundation for his scientific career. He maintains close and active collaboration with HKBU, frequently serving as an academic speaker and partnering with HKBU scholars on biomedical and cancer research. He remains dedicated to enhancing HKBU's academic reputation while actively engaging in international conferences to foster inter-institutional research collaborations. Upholding HKBU's motto "Faith and Perseverance", Professor Cho is a perfect embodiment of rigorous academic pursuit and selfless professional service.

## 曹志成教授, PhD 中醫學

曹志成教授於 2006 年取得香港浸會大學中醫學博士學位，是享譽國際的資深生物醫學科學家，現為伊利沙伯醫院臨床腫瘤科科學主任（醫學）。曹教授在臨床癌症研究領域深耕，致力推動全球醫學科學進步，將科研成果轉化為臨床應用，對提升癌症治療成效與患者福祉帶來變革性影響，成就卓越。

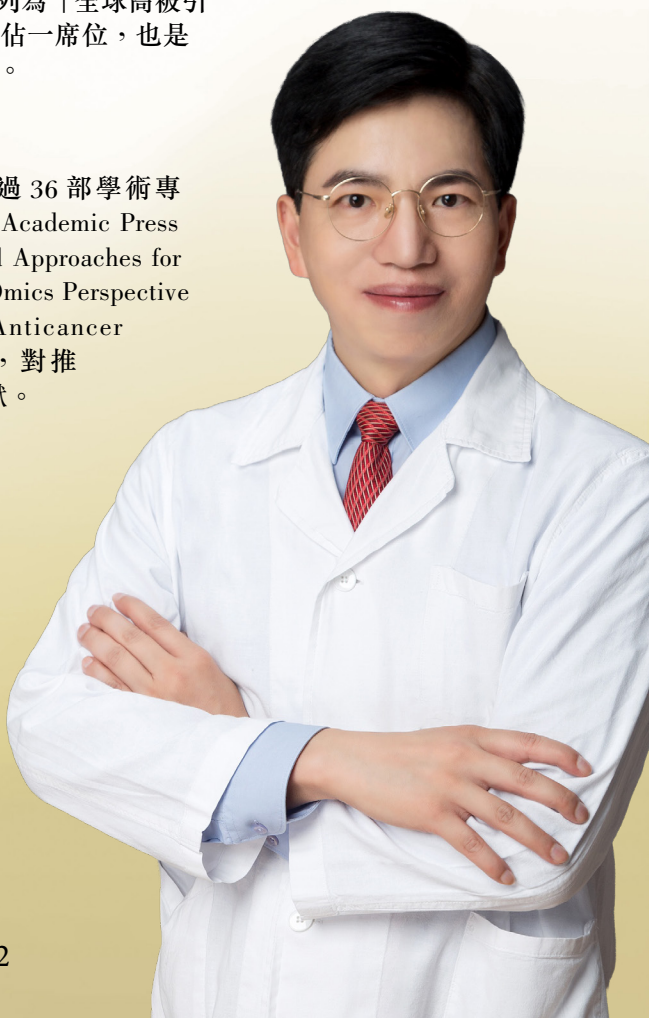
曹教授在專業領域的地位，體現在他獲得多個專業組織的院士榮譽。他自 1998 年成為英國生物醫學科學研究所院士（FIBMS）；並於 2003 年起成為香港醫務化驗學會院士（FHKIMLS），同年亦成為香港分子生物診斷學會院士（FHKSMDS）。此外，他自 2004 年起獲英國科學局認可為特許科學家，充分彰顯其在科學領域中卓越的專業能力與貢獻。

一直以來，曹教授專注於腫瘤學中最具挑戰性的核心問題：能否通過生物標誌物更早地檢測癌症，並更早發現復發？癌症如何產生耐藥性，以及如何逆轉這種耐藥性？他的跨學科研究涵蓋分子生物學、基因組學、免疫學、生物資訊學及中醫藥學，尤其聚焦於癌症生物標誌物、蛋白質組學、非編碼 RNA、細胞外囊泡及新型抗癌療法。他在肺癌、鼻咽癌和大腸癌生物標誌物的研究，為個人化治療策略提供了關鍵科學依據。

曹教授的學術成就斐然，他在全球專業科學期刊發表超過 700 篇論文，包括《Annals of Oncology》、《The Lancet Oncology》、《Molecular Cancer》以及《Journal of Thoracic Oncology》等，論文引用總次數逾 35,000 次，H 指數高達 108。自 2017 年起，曹教授連續多年躋身史丹福大學「全球前 2% 頂尖科學家」之列。2023 年及 2024 年，他更獲科睿唯安（Clarivate Analytics）列為「全球高被引學者」，在全球上榜的不足 7,000 名頂尖學者中佔一席位，也是醫院管理局內極少數獲得此國際殊榮的學者之一。

曹教授也是一位著作豐富的學者。他編撰超過 36 部學術專著，獲世界知名學府圖書館收藏，代表作包括 Academic Press 出版的《Resistance to Anti-CD20 Antibodies and Approaches for Their Reversal》、Springer Nature 出版的《An Omics Perspective on Cancer Research》及《Evidence-based Anticancer Complementary and Alternative Medicine》叢書，對推動實證中醫藥學邁向國際舞合作出了重大的貢獻。

曹教授對母校的栽培之恩始終銘記於心。多年來，他積極參與浸大的各類學術活動，經常回母校擔任學術講座講者，分享研究心得。他更與浸大研究團隊合作，進行生物醫學及抗癌研究，並積極參與國際學術會議，著力推動科研合作的同時，不忘宣揚母校的學術聲譽。曹教授以嚴謹治學的態度與敬業奉獻的精神，體現了浸大「篤信力行」的校訓，實為浸大人的典範。

### 得獎人介紹



**Dr Vincent Ho Wai-fung**  
Communication - Film / Video

Dr Vincent Ho Wai-fung graduated from the then Department of Communication (now the School of Communication) at Hong Kong Baptist College in 1993, majoring in Film and Video. Dr Ho is recognised for his vision and leadership at the intersection of media, arts, and emerging technologies. As an early advocate for the digitalisation of visual storytelling, he ventured beyond traditional confines to embrace newly emerging media in the industry. He has dedicated more than 30 years to integrating traditional cinematic techniques with technological advancements.

Dr Ho has shown his openness and close engagement with emerging industry trends throughout his career. With years of experiences in various media companies, he gained substantial insights into the regional media landscape. His leadership was recognised during his tenure as CEO of Southern Media Corporation's mobile television licensing business. In 2004, in collaboration with a leading mobile and telecom service provider in Hong Kong, he produced Asia's first 3G mobile microfilm series, *Love 123*, which received multiple Hong Kong ICT Awards. In 2013, his film *Love, Xi Shi Tofu* won the Best Short Film Award in a competition organised by China Central Television (CCTV)'s short film channel. In 2015, the film *Love Forever*, directed by Dr Ho, won an award for its special contribution at the 24th China Golden Rooster & Hundred Flowers Film Festival. In recent years, he has devoted himself to the advancement and application of digital technologies in media and arts. This demonstrates his profound capacity to adjust to an evolving media landscape and drive multidisciplinary innovation.

Beyond his professional accomplishments, Dr Ho is committed to public service and to promoting the arts in Hong Kong and on the Chinese Mainland. He is currently a member of the 13th Jilin Provincial Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference and the Hong Kong Arts Development Council, where he also serves as Chairman of its Arts Criticism Group. He is also President of the Hong Kong Film Critics Association and Director of the Hong Kong Rosamond Foundation. In these roles, he actively supports talent cultivation for the creative industry and promotes Chinese culture among the public. With a long-standing commitment to the development of national brands, Dr Ho has contributed immensely by promoting the introduction of the Chinese national automobile brand Hongqi into Hong Kong.

Despite his extensive commitments across various sectors, Dr Ho remains a dedicated supporter of his *alma mater*. He produced one of the ten short films celebrating the HKBU 60th Anniversary. He also serves as an Honorary Court member of HKBU and actively participates in university events. As the Founding President of the HKBU Alumni Association of the Greater Bay Area, he played a pivotal role in strengthening connections among alumni in the Greater Bay Area. Dr Ho truly exemplifies the "Whole-Person" quality, demonstrating a perfect balance between intellectual rigour and a strong commitment to societal advancement, and serves as a lasting inspiration to the HKBU community.

## 何緯豐博士 傳理學—電影電視

何緯豐博士於 1993 年畢業於香港浸會學院傳理學系（現為傳理學院），主修電影電視。作為早期視覺故事數碼化的倡導者，何博士在媒體、藝術與新興科技的多元領域展現出其開創性思維及領導力。30 多年來，他敢於跳出框架，因應行業趨勢迎接新媒體，致力融合傳統電影技術與尖端科技，對行業發展作出重大貢獻。

回顧其職業生涯，何博士對新興產業的行業趨勢不僅擁有廣闊的視野，更全情投入其中，不斷作出新嘗試。他先後於不同媒體工作，這些經驗促進他對地區媒體生態的了解，讓他洞察先機。他曾出任南方廣播影視傳媒集團手機電視牌照業務行政總裁，領導能力備受認可。2004 年，他與香港一家領先的電訊服務供應商合作，製作亞洲首部 3G 手機微電影《求愛 123》，該作品在香港資訊及通訊科技獎中屢獲殊榮。2013 年，他參與由中國中央電視台 (CCTV) 微電影頻道舉辦的「美麗中國極拍 48 小時」微電影競賽，其作品《愛·西施豆腐》於一眾團隊中脫穎而出，贏得最佳電影獎。2015 年，由何博士執導的電影《我們遇見松花湖》，於第 24 屆中國金雞百花電影節的民族電影展榮獲「特別貢獻獎」，成績斐然。近年，他銳意從文化藝術行業拓展至新興科技領域，充分展現其與時並進、跨界創新的卓越能力。

除了專業成就外，何博士亦熱心公益服務，致力推動香港與中國內地的藝術發展。他現為中國人民政治協商會議吉林省第十三屆委員會委員及香港藝術發展局委員，並在後者擔任藝術評論組主席。他亦是香港影評人協會會長及香港宋慶齡基金理事。透過這些公職，他積極支持創意產業的人才培育，並不遺餘力地向公眾推廣中華文化。何博士亦一直關注民族品牌的發展，他成功推動中國民族汽車品牌紅旗引入香港，貢獻良多。

儘管何博士在各界出任不同的職務，公務繁忙，他始終心繫母校，積極回饋。在浸大六十周年校慶之際，他製作了 10 齣短片的其中一齣獻給母校。另外，他是現任浸大諮議會榮譽委員，並熱衷參與大學活動。作為香港浸會大學大灣區校友會的創會會長，他對凝聚大灣區校友發揮了關鍵作用。何博士完美演繹了如何兼備精益求精的思維及服務社群、力求社會進步的堅定承擔，體現了「全人教育」的特質，啟發浸大社群竭盡所能，貢獻社會。

## 得獎人介紹



**Dr Sarah Lee Wai-sze, DSocSc, SBS, MH**  
Creative and Professional Writing

Dr Sarah Lee Wai-sze stands as one of the iconic sports figures in Hong Kong. Known by the household name “Cycling Goddess of Lower Ngau Tau Kok Estate”, she is a two-time Olympic bronze medallist. Dr Lee consistently demonstrates both unparalleled resilience on the track and remarkable academic endeavours off it. While dedicating her career to track cycling, she achieved notable academic results, earning a Bachelor’s Degree in Health Education from The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK) in 2017 and a second Bachelor’s Degree in Creative and Professional Writing from HKBU in 2023, the year she retired from the sport. Her continued pursuit of knowledge exemplifies her strong commitment to lifelong learning.

Dr Lee’s tremendous achievements in track cycling have established her as a leading athlete in the field. She first gained international recognition at the Guangzhou 2010 Asian Games by winning a gold medal in the Women’s 500m time trial, followed by a bronze medal in the Women’s Keirin at the London 2012 Olympic Games, marking Hong Kong, China’s first Olympic medal in cycling. In 2013, she earned her first “Rainbow Jersey” by clinching a gold medal in the Women’s 500m time trial at the UCI Track Cycling World Championships (World Championships). She achieved an even greater feat at the World Championships in 2019, earning “Double Rainbow Jersey” by clinching gold medals in both the Women’s Keirin and Women’s Sprint. Her status was further solidified at the Tokyo 2020 Olympics, where she captured another bronze medal in the Women’s Sprint. This made her the first Hong Kong athlete to win medals at two Olympic Games. Throughout her 19-year athletic career, she won a remarkable number of medals in Asian and world competitions, including three World Championship titles, five Asian Games gold medals and two Olympic Games bronze medals, setting records that have inspired young athletes.

Her outstanding accomplishments in sports have earned Dr Lee numerous prestigious accolades. She has been awarded several honours by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) of the People’s Republic of China, including the Medal of Honour (MH) in 2011, the Bronze Bauhinia Star (BBS) in 2017 and the Silver Bauhinia Star (SBS) in 2022. In 2018, she was named among the Ten Outstanding Young Persons by Junior Chamber International Hong Kong, China. Her influence extends beyond her athletic career, earning her recognition in academia for her extraordinary dedication. She was conferred an Honorary Fellowship by the EdUHK in 2019, a Doctor of Social Science, *honoris causa*, by Hong Kong Shue Yan University in 2022, and an Honorary Fellowship by The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology in 2023.

Dr Lee is also dedicated to contributing to the community by drawing on her experience and expertise. She co-founded “Music Flow”, a non-profit organisation providing music therapy services, and served as Cycling Head Coach for a Po Leung Kuk cycling programme targeting children with special educational needs, where she also trained the staff to become coaches. In 2022, she published her first book, *Every Scar on My Body* where she revealed how she persevered through the countless difficulties during her 19-year journey as a cyclist, including a serious accident that left her with constant pain in her left wrist during intensive training. The book won the best publishing award in the “Psychology and Inspiration” category at the Hong Kong Publishing Biennial Awards 2023.

As an engaged member of the HKBU community, Dr Lee spares no effort in sharing her Olympic experiences and insights through university talks, where she consistently conveys the “HKBU spirit” of faith and perseverance. She truly exemplifies humility in service, intellectual rigour, and a commitment to societal advancement. She is living proof that with unwavering dedication and determination, it is possible to excel regardless of life stages.

## 李慧詩博士, DSocSc, SBS, MH 創意及專業寫作

李慧詩博士是香港體壇其中一位的標誌性人物，作為兩屆奧運會銅牌得主，她是家喻戶曉的「牛下女車神」。她在運動場上展現堅毅不屈的鬥志，亦竭力於學術領域追求卓越。她在場地單車運動拼搏的同時，先後修讀兩個不同的學士學位，包括 2017 年於香港教育大學取得健康教育學士學位，以及在 2023 年——即其正式退役之年——在香港浸會大學取得創意及專業寫作學士學位。李博士求知若渴的態度，充分體現其終身學習的堅定信念。

李博士在場地單車運動的驕人成績，奠定了她於該領域的領導地位。2010 年，她於廣州亞運會摘下女子 500 米計時賽金牌，首度在國際舞台綻放光芒；2012 年，她於倫敦奧運會勇奪女子凱林賽銅牌，為中國香港於單車項目史上贏得首枚奧運獎牌。2013 年，她在場地單車世界錦標賽（世錦賽）女子 500 米計時賽摘金，首度披上「彩虹戰衣」，並於 2019 年世錦賽再創佳績，於女子凱林賽及爭先賽贏得雙料冠軍，取得「雙彩虹戰衣」。隨後，李博士在 2020 年東京奧運會再接再厲，於女子爭先賽勇奪銅牌，成為首位在兩屆奧運會均贏得獎牌的香港運動員。回顧李博士 19 年的運動生涯，她於亞洲及世界賽事奪得多枚獎牌，包括三項世錦賽冠軍、五枚亞運會金牌及兩枚奧運會銅牌，締造場地單車運動的歷史，激勵後進。

李博士傑出的體育成就深受各界肯定，屢獲殊榮。她於 2011 年獲中華人民共和國香港特別行政區政府頒授榮譽勳章（MH）、2017 年獲頒授銅紫荊星章（BBS），以及 2022 年獲頒授銀紫荊星章（SBS），並於 2018 年獲國際青年商會中國香港總會選為「十大傑出青年」。其影響力遠超體壇，學術界亦對其非凡貢獻予以肯定：她於 2019 年獲香港教育大學頒授榮譽院士、2022 年獲香港樹仁大學頒授榮譽社會科學博士，以及 2023 年獲香港科技大學頒授榮譽大學院士。

李博士亦致力以經驗及專長回饋社會。她聯合創辦專門提供音樂治療服務的非牟利機構「音樂流」（Music Flow），並擔任保良局「保寶單車教室」的總教練，指導有特殊教育需要（SEN）的兒童和培訓職員成為教練。2022 年，她出版首部著作《身上的每道傷疤》，細訴 19 年單車生涯的箇中辛酸，包括一次於訓練期間遇上嚴重意外後，如何克服左手手腕重傷引致長期劇痛的心路歷程。該作品更榮獲 2023 年「香港出版雙年獎」心理勵志類別的最佳出版獎。

作為浸大社群的一分子，李博士樂於回饋母校，透過校園分享會分享她參與奧運會的經驗與心得，傳遞浸大「篤信力行」的精神。她謙虛待人、力臻至善及推動社會進步的堅持，實為完美詮釋在不同人生階段皆能成就卓越的最佳例證。

### 得獎人介紹



**Mr Yuen Chi-wai, SBS, JP**  
Communication

Mr Yuen Chi-wai graduated from the then Department of Communication (now the School of Communication) at Hong Kong Baptist College in 1978, majoring in Television Production — a discipline that has shaped his career for nearly five decades. A prominent figure in Hong Kong's broadcasting industry, he currently serves as the Assistant General Manager (News and Information Services) at Television Broadcasts Limited (TVB). In this executive role, he provides strategic oversight of the production and editorial direction of all news programmes, covering public affairs, financial information, and sports, solidifying the station's status as a leading

powerhouse of news for the community.

Mr Yuen has a lifelong commitment to broadcast journalism. He began his professional journey in 1977 before graduation, by joining TVB's News Department as News Anchor. After graduation, he advanced through positions including Reporter, Assistant News Editor, and Managing News Editor, delivering global news to local households. During these years, he played a pivotal role in producing programmes focusing on social issues such as *97 Magazine* and *SAR Magazine*. In 1995, he was appointed Senior Executive Producer of the Public Affairs Department, where he produced and hosted special news programmes focusing on Hong Kong's Return to the Motherland.

After a distinguished 22-year career in news reporting, Mr Yuen transitioned to the management team at TVB in 1999. Tasked with safeguarding the quality of professional news programmes, he served in a number of key roles including Public Affairs Manager, Assistant News Controller, Deputy News Controller, and News Controller, before being promoted to Assistant General Manager in 2016. Under his leadership, TVB's news and public affairs programmes have earned tremendous international recognition at various global stages — including the prestigious Peabody Awards, the New York Festivals TV & Film Awards, the Monte-Carlo Television Festival, and the Asian Television Awards — winning over 100 global accolades.

Beyond the newsroom, Mr Yuen's professionalism and valuable contributions to the broadcasting and media industry have been recognised by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China. He was appointed Justice of the Peace (JP) in 2017 and awarded the Silver Bauhinia Star (SBS) in 2023. These honours acknowledge his significant impact in the media industry, as well as his contributions in producing highly educational information programmes about the Chinese Mainland and Hong Kong.

Throughout his career, Mr Yuen has remained a steadfast supporter of HKBU. In addition to sharing his professional experience with students, in a true display of the HKBU spirit, he also performed in the 50th Anniversary Variety Show, an event celebrating the tight bonding between the alumni and the University. He further demonstrated his commitment to the University by serving on the Organising Committee for Communication and Publicity for the HKBU 60th Anniversary. Mr Yuen exemplifies the excellence and perseverance that the University aims to cultivate in its students and graduates.

## 袁志偉先生, SBS, JP 傳理學

袁志偉先生於 1978 年畢業於香港浸會學院傳理學系（現為傳理學院），主修電視製作，奠定了他日後於廣播業界馳騁近 50 載的堅實基礎。袁先生現任電視廣播有限公司（無綫電視）助理總經理（新聞及資訊），負責監管所有新聞節目的製作與編採方向，涵蓋公共事務、財經資訊及體育，並擔當重要的決策角色，鞏固了該台於本地新聞界的領導地位。

袁先生終身奉獻給廣播新聞事業，矢志不移。1977 年，他於畢業前便已加入無綫電視新聞部擔任新聞主播。畢業後，他先後擔任記者、助理採訪主任及編輯主任，將全球局勢傳遞到本港千家萬戶。期間，他製作多個關注社會議題的節目，例如《九七透視》及《時局縱橫》等。1995 年，袁先生獲委任為公共事務部高級監製，策劃並主持多個新聞專題節目，深入報道香港回歸祖國的歷史時刻。

經過 22 載於新聞前線的豐富歷練，袁先生於 1999 年起退居幕後，獲擢升為無綫電視管理層。他先後擔任公共事務經理、助理新聞總監、副新聞總監及新聞總監，並於 2016 年晉升為助理總經理。在他的領導下，無綫電視的新聞及公共事務節目在國際舞台上屢獲殊榮，包括享譽國際的美國皮博迪獎 (Peabody Awards)、紐約電視電影節 (New York Festivals TV & Film Awards)、蒙地卡羅電視節 (Monte-Carlo Television Festival) 及亞洲電視大獎 (Asian Television Awards) 等，贏得超過一百項全球性獎項，成績斐然。

除了在傳媒界的專業貢獻，袁先生多年來對社會的傑出貢獻亦備受中華人民共和國香港特別行政區政府肯定。他於 2017 年獲委任為太平紳士 (JP)，並於 2023 年獲頒授銀紫荊星章 (SBS)。這些榮銜均彰顯他在傳媒界出類拔萃的成就，並表彰他製作的新聞資訊節目別具教育意義，對促進大眾對中國內地與香港社會發展的了解，作出了重大貢獻。

在專業新聞路上拼搏的同時，袁先生始終心繫母校。他不僅樂意與學生分享專業經驗，更在 2006 年的浸大五十周年校慶綜藝匯演中擔綱演出，以實際行動展示校友與母校之間的深厚聯繫，體現浸大人的精神。此外，他亦曾擔任浸大六十周年校慶傳訊及公關活動籌備委員會成員，積極貢獻所長。袁先生以其精益求精與堅持不懈的精神，充分展現浸大作育英才的成果，是學生及校友學習的榜樣。
